1. Primary analysis restricted to studies at low (or low and unclear) risk of bias. The first approach involves defining a threshold, based on key bias domains (see Section 8.7) such that only studies meeting specific criteria are included in the primary analysis. The threshold may be determined using the original review eligibility criteria, or using reasoned argument (which may draw on empirical evidence of bias from meta-epidemiological studies).
