Advanced Placement (AP) The dreaded DBQ, or "document-based question," is an essay question type on the AP History exams (AP US History, AP European History, and AP World History). For the DBQ essay, you will be asked to analyze some historical issue or trend with the aid of the provided sources, or "documents," as evidence.

What is a DBQ? The Document-Based Question Explained

In American Advanced Placement exams, a document-based question (DBQ), also known as data-based question, is an essay or series of short-answer questions that is constructed by students using one's own knowledge combined with support from several provided sources. Usually, it is

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employed on timed history tests.

Students in Jennifer Gilrein's World History class give each other feedback on their Document-Based Questions. Before sharing their DBQs with peers, students set goals to focus the feedback they will solicit. Jennifer encourages students to use the AP DBQ rubric to guide their goal setting and feedback. Students then work together to give each other warm and cool feedback on each others' essays.
