Earth has a nitrogen-oxygen atmosphere, but both Venus and Mars have carbon dioxide atmospheres. Earth has a water-rich atmosphere, in which 1% of atmospheric gases are water molecules. But both Mars and Venus have extremely dry; atmospheres. Mars has proportionately 30x fewer atmospheric water molecules than Earth; and Venus is 300x poorer in water than Mars.
