Unscrew an oil cooler line from the radiator using the line wrench. This will spill out some oil, so you may want to keep the drain pan handy. Follow the oil line to the oil filter, and unbolt the bracket that holds the oil lines to the engine using the 3/8-inch ratchet and socket.

Occasionally it may be necessary to remove an internal 911 oil cooler while the motor is still in the car. Whether to replace the seals, or to replace a damaged cooler, removing and replacing the cooler does not require the removal of the motor from the car.

Prepare a mixture of dishwasher detergent and hot water (Some people will use a Vinegar mixture). Use a rate of two ounces (dry measurement) of detergent to one gallon of clean water. Also, Make sure to mix enough solution to be able to fill the entire cooling system. Finally, Fill the cooling system from the highest point possible.

Oil Mixed With Coolant In The Cooling System - Cleaning Tips

One solution is to add a heat exchanger or oil cooler. This simple system will take the oil away from the engine, run it through a series of coils, and with the help of a fan, it will cool the oil before returning it on its' route through the oil filter.
