$B^2 - AC > 0$  (hyperbolic partial differential equation): hyperbolic equations retain any discontinuities of functions or derivatives in the initial data. An example is the wave equation . The motion of a fluid at supersonic speeds can be approximated with hyperbolic PDEs, and the Euler–Tricomi equation is hyperbolic where  $x > 0$  .

### Symmetric Hyperbolic Linear Differential Equations

Due to the fact that boundary value problems for non-linear elliptic equations do not always have a solution and that boundary value (mixed) problems for non-linear parabolic and hyperbolic equations need not have a solution for all  $t > 0$  , a theory of non-existence of solutions for non-linear partial differential equations has been developed.
