### Overcoming Transcendence: Charles Taylor and Nihilism - CORE

Taylor himself articulates three senses of transcendence, three dimensions in which we go "beyond": a good higher than human flourishing (such as love in the sense of agape), a higher power (such as God), and extension of life (or even "our lives") beyond the "natural" scope between birth and death (summarized on p. 20). He is clearly concerned to bring out what is distinctive to a religious rather than a secular orientation.

Taylor also advances the controversial view that (3) there is an ineradicable draw to `transcendence' in human life in connection to the quest for the meaning of life. But, as Charles Taylor has pointed out, "authenticity" is a highly ambiguous word in contemporary parlance.
