This hysteria was supposed to be a build-up of fluid in the woman’s womb and doctors assumed that since men ejaculated and felt better then it stood to reason.

The most common ailment a physician treated was hysteria in women, which was basically a result of sexual frustration resulting from living in the repressive Victorian upper class. Hysteria was treated either with a prescription for laudanum (a combination of opium, herbs and alcohol), hypnosis, or a pelvic massage to induce a paroxysm.
