The purpose of the Decision Making Tool for SLD and LI Eligibility is not solely to document procedural requirements for compliance, rather it is a tool to guide the team's analysis. As a secondary purpose, it provides a vehicle for the required documentation.

### FINAL Decision Making Tool for SLD and LI Eligibility for AMM

Provide evidence that substantiates the team's decision: If the answer to any of questions C.1 through C.3 is YES, the student is not eligible for specially designed instruction and related services in accordance with the SLD or the LI rules. Continue to address student needs through systematic problem solving.

When making a determination of SLD, the ARC must consider all of the data and use the following to guide the eligibility decision: The RtI component of the evaluation must evidence underachievement (level) and insufficient growth (rate).

### **SLD Guidelines - Special Education**

Determining if a student has a specific learning disability, like any other disability determination under IDEA, cannot be based on any single criterion - meaning a single test, assessment, observation, or report. An evaluation of a student suspected of having SLD must include a variety of assessment tools and strategies.
