Aggressive national campaign for federal child labor law reform begins. 1916 New federal law sanctions state violators. First federal child labor law prohibits movement of goods across state lines if minimum age laws are violated (law in effect only until 1918, when it's declared unconstitutional, then revised, passed, and declared unconstitutional again)
