Divided into six parts, Diaspora: Five Million, Spain (1565-1898), U.S.A. (1898-1946), Japan (World War II:1942-1946), Witness, and The Gods we Worship Live Next Door (A Poem in Eleven Parts), Bino Realuyo traces the history of a people. Diaspora opens with a poem entitled "Filipineza." This poem sets the mood of the entire collection and tells the reader that this is more than pretty poetry, while more than a political statement.
